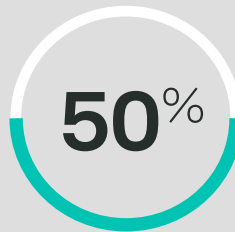


EV Charging Incentive

The Government of Canada (through NRCan) is investing millions annually to fund publicly accessible Level 2 and Level 3 charging stations at businesses throughout Canada until 2027.

Installation costs covered:

The incentive is limited to 50% of total project costs*, up to a maximum of \$10M per project:

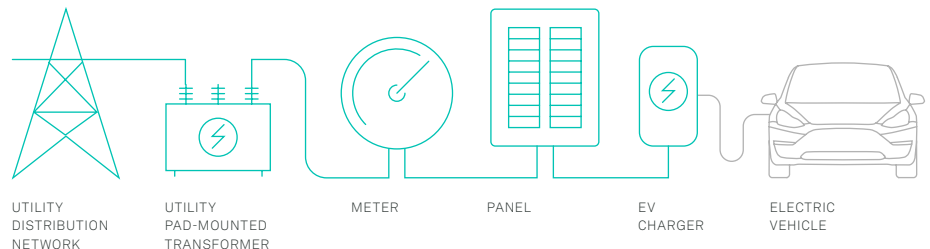
Level 2 → \$5,000 per connector

DC Fast → \$15,000 to 100,000 per charger
(range depending on kW output)
